Our Goals For Student Achievement

Students

I, as a student, will do my best to meet the state's academic standards by:

1. Following the student code of conduct and attendance policies;
2. Completing all school assignments to the best of my ability at school and at home;
3. Reading at least 20 minutes daily every day outside of school time;
4. Practicing math facts daily; and
5. Giving my parents all notices and information sent home from the school.

Parents

We, as parents, will support our child's learning in the following ways:

1. Ensuring my child arrives at school on time every day;
2. Keeping my child at school all day whenever possible;
3. Making sure homework is completed;
4. Actively participating in my child's education
5. Encouraging my child to read daily;
6. Practicing math facts with my child daily;
7. Reading and, if appropriate, responding to all notices from the school; and
8. Sharing my ideas for school improvement with the school.

Marti Elementary will:

Provide high-quality curriculum and instruction in a supportive and effective learning environment that enables children to demonstrate mastery on all required state assessments by:

1. Following state mandated curriculum;
2. Assessing student progress annually;
3. Responding to student academic difficulties in a timely, effective manner;
4. Hiring only highly-qualified personnel;
5. Providing ongoing professional development to instructional personnel.

Offer parent teacher conferences by:

1. Providing parents with times of teacher conference periods at the beginning of the school year; and
2. Scheduling them at a mutually convenient time at the request of either the parent or the teacher.

Provide parents with frequent reports on their child's progress by:

1. Sending home 3-week progress reports through Skyward;
2. Sending home report cards every 6 weeks through Skyward; and
3. Providing access to state assessment results annually.

Provide parents with reasonable access to staff by:

1. Providing parents with the times of teacher conference periods at the beginning of the school year
2. Scheduling at least one open house event annually.

Provide parents with opportunities to volunteer and participate in their child's class by:

1. Referring parents to the Parent-School Liaison for volunteer opportunities.
