Important Dates

Online Paperwork Information

- All Rank one paper needs to be completed by September 4th.
- Only incoming 7th grade athletes will need a physical for this year unless you are new to the district as an 8th grade athlete. We will be using last years physical for all present 8th graders, unless you answered “YES” to any of the questions 1-6 on the medical history form. You will need a new physical at this time.

The QR Code, on the next slide, will take you to the Rank One Public App in the App Store. The Rank One Sport mobile app allows users to log in to their existing Rank One Sport account and access information using your iOS device.

This app will allow the parents and/or student-athlete to complete their daily COVID 19 Daily Screening. Students and parents can also complete and update medical paperwork on the app. There is also the option to receive schedule change alerts and game details. The app also allows users to sync schedules to a personal calendar.

Cross Country Information

- First day of practice will be September 8th.
- Practice will begin at 6:15 am each morning. Remote learners will be able to come at 4pm after school until 5:00 pm.
- Football players are able to run cross country and play football. They **will not** practice cross country on (Tuesday) the day they have a football game.
- All online paperwork has to be completed before your son can practice for any sport.
- Due to Covid -19 all athletes will need to bring their own water bottles and masks to wear when not running. We will have refill stations for them to have more water.

Football Information

- 7th and 8th grade football practice will be held after school from 4:00 - 5:45 pm. We will practice Monday through Friday. On wednesdays the players will be released at 5:30 to attend church if they do so.
- Games will be played on Tuesday Nights. Any parent can choose to have their child ride home with them after an athletic event. They must sign out with the Head Coach for their sport before they can leave.
- Due to Covid -19 all athletes will need to bring their own water bottles and masks to use when not competing in a drill. We will have refill stations for them to have more water. We will provide some cups as well, but the number of cups are uncertain at this time.
- All online paperwork must be completed before any athlete can practice after school.

Medical Inhalers and Epipens

- Athletes will be allowed to carry their own medical inhalers and Epipens with them to practice and to games as long as the proper paperwork has been filled out with the school nurse at your campus.
